Dear Resident:

As we enter into our 97th year serving the community at large, Middletown Public Library is celebrating its ninth year as a nonprofit library (501(c)(3) organization). The library continues to find ways to innovate and is excited about the future as the world continues to return to normal.

- Our adult programs include our monthly in-person book clubs, the General Book Club and the Mystery Book Club and our virtual groups, the Science Fiction Book Club and the Star Trek Rewatch Group. Our children's programs include Storytime, Tales with T.A.I.L.S., the LEGO Club, and the STEM Club.
- Our Summer Reading Program in 2022 had free live performances each week for area children at St. Peter's Lutheran Church and afterwards the children enjoyed a free lunch provided by the Middletown Area School District (MASD). The summer program was also an opportunity for community involvement, such as partnering with St. Peter's, MASD and their Middletown Area Recreational Association (MARA). Many local businesses and organizations helped support the program and we received generous donations from the George Frey Trust, the Kiwanis Club of Middletown, and the Hershey Company.
- We have been proactive in our fundraising, receiving grants/funds this past year from the American Rescue Plan (ARP), UGI, and the Hershey Rotary. We had a far-reaching appeal letter campaign, and we held book sales in the Spring and Fall of 2022.
- We are associated with the Science Fiction Book Club on Facebook, a science fiction literature discussion group, which has over 9,600 members. The group has members in all 50 states and 64 other countries around the world.

We are committed to protecting your investment and providing our communities with quality library service, but we need your help. Our funding challenges are real, and they are significant.

The library serves area residents in many ways. These people are your neighbors, your friends and quite possibly yourself. These are some examples of services provided from this past year:

- Patrons borrowed many types of items: books, DVDs, audiobooks, e-books, and e-audiobooks.
- Children from a local nursery school came to the library weekly to learn library skills and develop a love of reading and the arts.
- Many people used our computers to work on their resumes and to apply for jobs.
- Patrons were assisted with evaluating the validity of online information.
- United Way's tax assistance program, held at the library, helped to prepare tax returns for 3,271 families in the capital region that resulted in almost \$4,666,937 in refunds. In addition, the library is one of the few remaining locations in the area that still offers paper tax forms.

This library was started through the generosity, vision and dedication of many benefactors and volunteers. These gifts of time and money represented a sacrifice on each donor's part, and our goal is to honor that sacrifice by continuing to provide library service for many years to come. We have already taken the initial step by reaching out to you, our residents. Your support allows us to move forward. Your help plays a BIG part in our ability to make a difference in people's lives. Take a moment to reflect on what the public library brings to your community – and help keep it going for many more years to come.
